Charge: (draft)

The "data working group" will develop a vision and value proposition for a system spanning preschool, K-12 and postsecondary education and training that will provide:

- High profile results-oriented information to a wide audience of state and community leaders and the public; and
- Actionable information to educators, community organizations, parents and others with a high degree of interest in educational issues.

The group's work should address the types of data to be included, provide examples of information as defined above, describe how this information might be used by prospective users, and suggest some new "results-oriented" information that could be made available by 9/1/2010 to increase awareness of the value of this work among leadership groups.

The group will also generally describe several options as to how the state might create such a system. In describing these options, the group should not limit itself to any one technology approach nor assume that the use of the word "system" refers to a single physical infrastructure or any other configuration. While the group may choose to recommend a specific approach, its report should encompass the range of generally recognized approaches to such an effort whether the group agrees with a specific approach or not.
