



Student Opinions Sought on College Transfer

HARTFORD, December 10 — Connecticut college students are invited to share their views and recommendations for easing college transfer at a special forum to be conducted by the Board of Governors for Higher Education on **Wednesday, December 19th** at the Legislative Office Building in Hartford.

Students, counselors, faculty, administrators and others are encouraged to present their comments to the Board of Governors at 1:00 pm. in Room 1D of the LOB. The Board of Governors is seeking proposals for smoothing the transfer of credits among colleges, particularly in labor shortage fields such as business, nursing and allied health. The forum and hearing are part the Board's statewide effort to strengthen transfer as required by Public Act 01-165 passed last session by the General Assembly. The Board of Governors is the state's coordinating agency for higher education.

The day will begin at 10:00 am. with discussions and presentations by state lawmakers, college presidents and experts from Massachusetts. All sessions are open to the public.
